#### 1. Management and Administrative Services

A licensed Community Association Manager fulfilling all our community on-site office needs under the State of Florida Statutes. Our Manager ensures all vendors performing work on site are licensed and insured and are held responsible for all the work performed. Management prepares bid packages for vendors to make sure that proposals presented to the Board of Directors for their vote, are equal in specifications and expected job performance. The Property Manager oversees the staff and the work they perform and to guide them when needed to ensure quality service. Delivery of all important correspondence and accounting documentation to and from our on-site office at Coral Trace and Seacrest's Corporate office is performed on a weekly, or as needed, schedule to make sure invoices are paid on time and that the Association is represented as a professionally run business.

#### 2. Accounting Services

- Seacrest s Accounting Dept. is responsible for day-today accounting services and represented by two exceptional accounting representatives, one overseeing account receivables and the other account payables, and both do an exceptional job for the community.
- Accounting, with the assistance of the Property Manager, creates an pre-draft budget annually and presents it to the Board of Directors and Treasurer for their review and final input.

#### **Coral Trace CERT Update**

CERT is a very important part of training for our survival in the event of a hurricane or other community disaster. You are invited to take our training and participate in this important community service.

The next City of Delray Beach Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) basic training class starts around October 1, 2017. Training classes are held beginning at 6:00 pm until 9:00 pm.

Location is the second floor in training rooms A/B/C of the Delray Beach Fire Department Headquarters, 501 West Atlantic Ave., Delray Beach FL, 33444. Participants must pre-register by contacting **Coral Trace resident Ed Howard Sr.** at **biblehubby@yahoo.com** or CERT volunteer Lillian Gallego at lilliangallego@gmail.com or by calling 561-243 -7400.

This course consists of 21 hours of training one night a week for seven weeks. Classes are taught by trained Professional Firefighters and Paramedics from the City Of Delray Beach.

#### 2017 COURSE TOPICS

Unit #1: / Intro to CERT/Disaster Preparedness Course review, content and scheduling. Introduction to disasters, Meteorology 101, impact of disasters on infrastructures.

#### Unit #2: / Disaster Fire Suppression

Identifying and reducing potential fire hazards, fire extinguisher use, fire suppression strategy, firefighting resources, firefighting techniques.

Unit #3: / Disaster Medical Operations Part 1 Treatment strategies for life threatening conditions and principles of triage.

Unit #4: / Disaster Medical Operations Part 2
Basic First Aid, Head to toe assessments, treatment for head wounds, treatment for fractures, sprains, burns and other injuries.

Unit #5: / Light Search and Rescue Operations Search / Rescue priorities and resources, rescuer safety. Techniques for size-up and search. Cribbing and removing lightly trapped victims.

Unit #6: / Disaster Psychology and Terrorism
The post-disaster emotional environment. Define Terrorism; identify actions to take before, during and following a suspected terrorist incident.

Unit #7: / Review / Disaster Simulation Exercise / Graduation

## It's here! Are you ready? Plan, Prepare and Protect

Have you prepared for the 2017 hurricane season yet? The time to make important arrangements is **NOW!** 

Weather services predict an above-average storm season with between 13 - 17 named storms between June 1 and November 30.



Heavy rains and tropical storm systems brewing in the Caribbean have given several early warnings that we can expect a very active season this year!

Your Coral Trace HOA has taken several precautionary measures to safeguard our community and ensure that trees and foliage have been trimmed to avoid major damage.

Your HOA also maintains a CERT (Community Emergency Response Team) to assist with emergency needs after the storm. (See related article by Ed Howard on page 2 that announces next training in October 2017.)

Basic preparation and plans by individual residents and homeowners can make all the difference in how you and your family weather a storm safely and recover quickly afterward!

#### Where to start?

 The PBC Hurricane Guide below is the most comprehensive source of local information for before, during and after the storm. \*You might want to print it out ahead of time in case power is not available at a later time.

 Special needs? These shelters require pre-registration and are available for persons with medical conditions with disabilities such as oxygen or nursing care by <u>pre-registering</u> <u>with a call to **561-712-6400**.</u> There are very limited pet friendly shelters available that also require <u>pre-registration at the same</u> number.

- Secure your property Give your hurricane shutters a "test drive" and if necessary, a tune-up to be sure they are in good working order. (If needed, in the event of special circumstances, we are fortunate to live right next door to Atlantic High School which is a designated shelter.)
- Stock up on basic supplies including any necessary prescriptions, nonperishable food, batteries, and first aid items.
- Know your "zone" and what resources during and after the storm are available in your area.
- Check out the detailed information and checklists at the links at left and below to cover all your bases for securing your home, yourself, and your family before during and after the storm.


