RUN/WALK = 1 time around the small loop

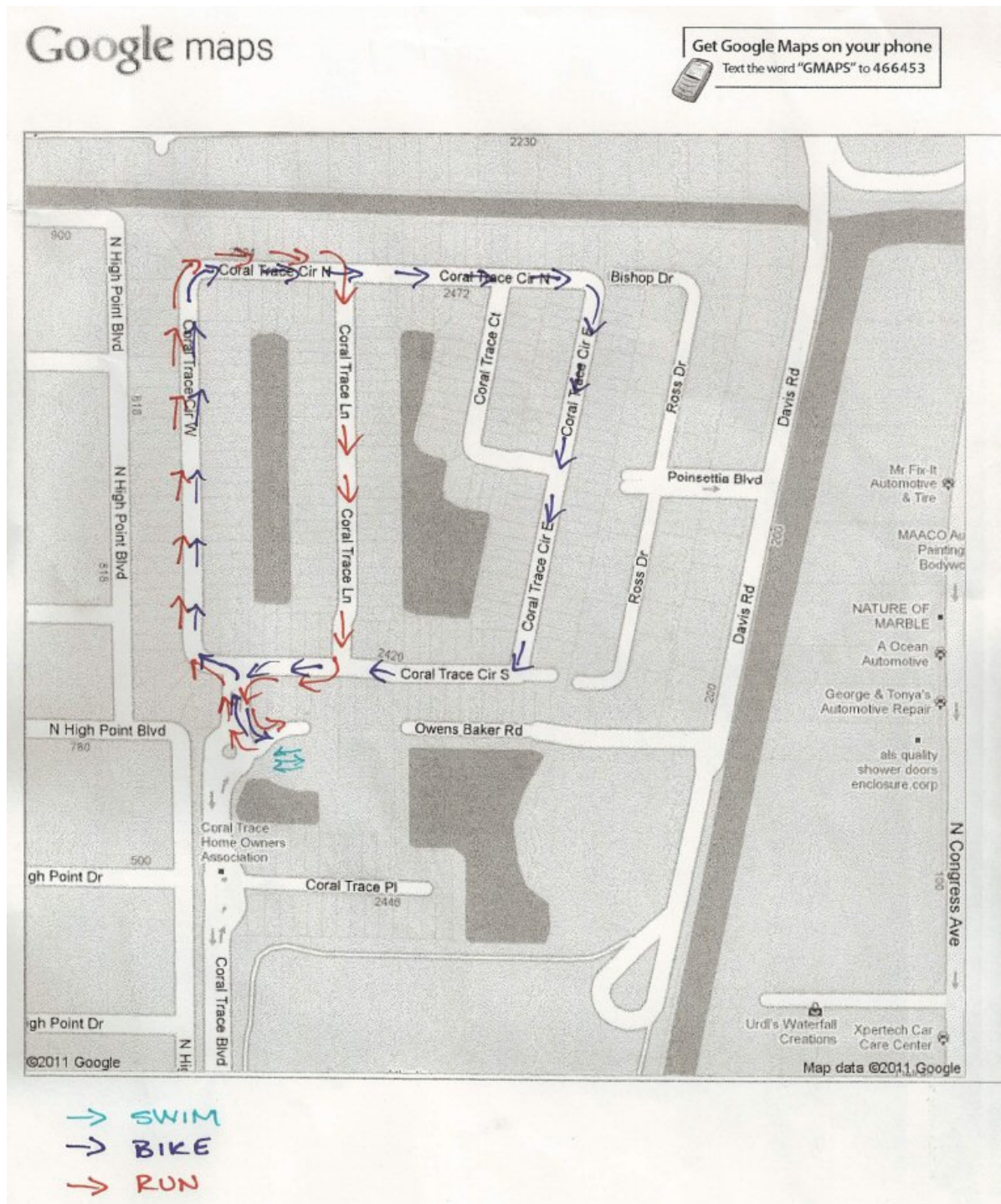
Where: The Clubhouse Parking Lot

Thinking of buying an electric car? You live in the right place! The City of Delray Beach now provides 3 EV Charging Stations for public use. They are located in the Banker's Row Parking Lot, corner of NE 1st Ave and NE 2nd Street. Time to check out that new VOLT! The stations were donated by a Delray Beach resident who is Executive Director of Plug In Florida.

New: Delray Beach Action Center—24x7 online service center to ask a question, submit and track a request, report a problem (street lights out etc). Go to www.mydelraybeach.com, Self-Service, and select Delray Beach Action Center.

Delray Beach Family Recreation and Fitness Center—New playground at corner of Lake Ida Rd. and North Congress Ave.

Preparing for Hurricane Season: Hurricane Season begins June 1st and the time to prepare is **now**. Residents are urged to keep important contact information readily available and to plan ahead by taking these precautionary steps:

- Supply your household with nonperishable food and water for 5-7 days (minimum of one gallon of water per person per day is recommended).
- Stock up on batteries & flashlights. Don't forget to charge your cell phones and fill your vehicle's gas tank prior to the storm hitting.
- Organize & package important documents preferably in waterproof containers or sealed plastic bags.
- Have an insulated cooler available especially for medication that requires refrigeration.
- Designate an out-of-state family member or friend as a single point of contact should loved ones become separated. If you live alone, arrange a "buddy" system with a friend or neighbor.
- If you are disabled and need medical assistance during a storm, register in advance for a special needs shelter. Space is limited and preregistration
